

SUMMER 2021 STRING AND BAND DAY CAMPS

Schedule Details

STRING CAMP June 14-18 | **BAND CAMP** June 21-25

While every pod will have a different schedule, start and end times each day remain the same.

8:00 - 9:00 a.m. Drop Off

4:00 - 4:30 p.m. Pick Up*

4:00 - 6:00 p.m. After Camp Care

*Students not picked up by 4:30 p.m. will automatically transition to After Camp Care where charges will apply.

Drop Off Camps will be using two main buildings on campus - the Boesel Musical Arts building which houses the Conservatory of Music (49 Seminary Street) and the St. Adalbert School facility (66 Adalbert Street). Campers will receive a specific location where they should be dropped off. Upon drop off, temperatures will be taken and staff will greet campers at their drop off locations to check them in. Information about drop off locations and time will be sent to families before the start of camp.

Morning Homeroom The goal of homeroom is to connect campers with their peers and to the rest of the camp through larger virtual gatherings. Campers will be placed in a pod based on their pod placement recording, instrument and grade. Pods are designed to keep students in smaller groups while also allowing them to achieve musical growth with their peers. Homeroom is where each pod will explore creative, artistic, musical and leadership skills. Trained counselors will guide campers through new daily activities.

Rehearsals Campers will be working on pod-specific repertoire through the direction of our camp conductors. Rehearsal with a conductor is scheduled daily for each pod. The final 'performance' of the repertoire will be recorded at the end of the week and sent to families to watch together after camp!

Lunch Included with tuition, the BW student dining hall will provide healthy grab-and-go meals for campers each day. Dairy-free, gluten-free and vegetarian options are available, but campers must make this preference known on their registration form. Anyone with a special food allergy is encouraged to contact our office. Students may also bring their own lunch, but refrigeration will NOT be available.

Weather permitting, meals will be eaten outside on a campus lawn or under outdoor tents. In the event of rain, large, indoor dining spaces will be used while allowing students to space out.

Sectionals/Guided Practice/Special Session This time will be customized for each pod based on the needs of the group throughout the week. Campers will receive time to practice (with guidance) in a private practice room, participate in a sectional with a professional faculty member, or participate in a guest artist workshop. The variety of this time will continue to engage campers and provide them the opportunity to develop their musical skills.

Afternoon Homeroom Campers will end each day in their homerooms. This gives students a chance to reflect on the day, receive updates of the next day of camp and connect with their peers and staff.

Pick Up Campers will be picked up in specific zones based on their pod placement. This will decrease traffic, crowding and provide a smooth checkout process.

After Camp Care (optional) [After Camp Care](#) is available for campers between 4:00 p.m. and 6:00 p.m. This allows for greater flexibility in pick up times. During this time campers will be engaged in a wide variety of musical and recreational activities. Additional fees apply.
